Palomar Promise (1 Year Scholarship)

Deadline: First come, first served (Apply ASAP)

- All first-time college students (not just graduating high school seniors) who will be enrolling for classes at Palomar College.
- Applicants are considered first-time college students if they have not taken any college courses AFTER their high school graduation.
- No minimum GPA to apply.
- Must enroll full-time (12 units or more) per semester.
- Submit the FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application and add Palomar College (School Code: 001260) on application by 3/2/19.
- Benefits include free tuition for the first year (up to 19 units per semester), financial assistance for textbooks, parking permit and more.
